NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby supports the request to dedicate the Highway 158 Bridge over the Northern Beltway in the Walkertown Community to the memory of Officer Stephen L. Amos, II, who was killed in the line of duty on February 28, 1995.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Manager is hereby authorized to complete the necessary related documents, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
